What to know:

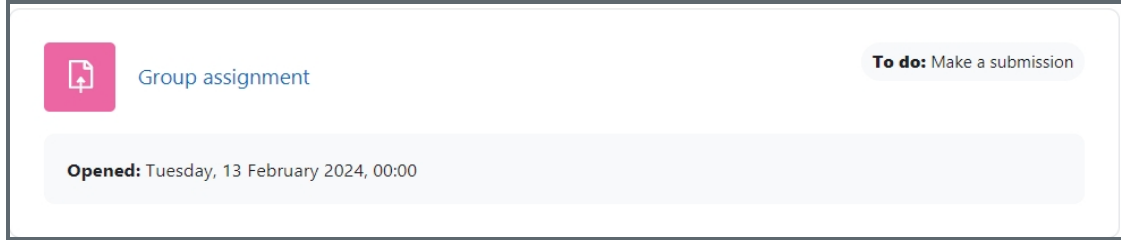
Students can submit an assignment in group. Then each member in the group will get the same score of their group work.
