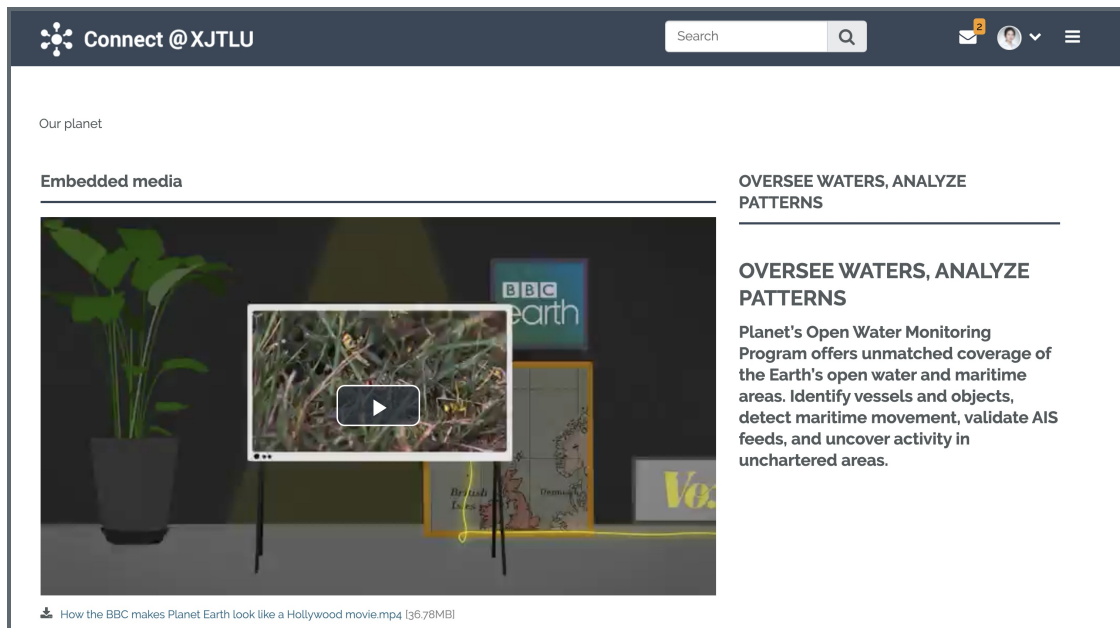


# How to submit a group connect page/collection to LM Core?

## Overview:

This guide will show you how to submit a group work in connect to the Learning Mall Core assignment. If the "Assignment" activity is well set by the teacher, students will only need to work together on the Connect page([connect.xjtlu.edu.cn](http://connect.xjtlu.edu.cn)), and one representative will be in charge of submitting for all at the end. However, at this moment, project created in a Connect group can't be found on the list when students are trying to submit (they can only find their personal pages). The only solution now is to ask the group administrator copy the page/collection into his/her own account, and submit to LM Core later.

## What to know:

Only Group administrator can manage the group and change the work copying allowed. After copying the page/collection, you can disable the function as you like.

2. Click the "Share" on the top bar, and click "Page" category to find the page you want to copy. Click the lock shape icon to open the setting page.

## Share | Example group v.2 ?

**Collections**

**Pages**

Allow comments  Yes

Allow users to leave comments.

Moderate comments  No

Comments on pages and artefacts remain private until you approve them. Comments by people not logged into their accounts always go into a moderation queue and need to be approved.

**Allow copying**  Yes

If people have access to your selected pages / collections, they can make their own copies.

Copy for existing group members  No

Copy the selected pages / collections to the personal portfolio area of all existing group members. The slide switch resets after saving. Group members will only get a copy once.

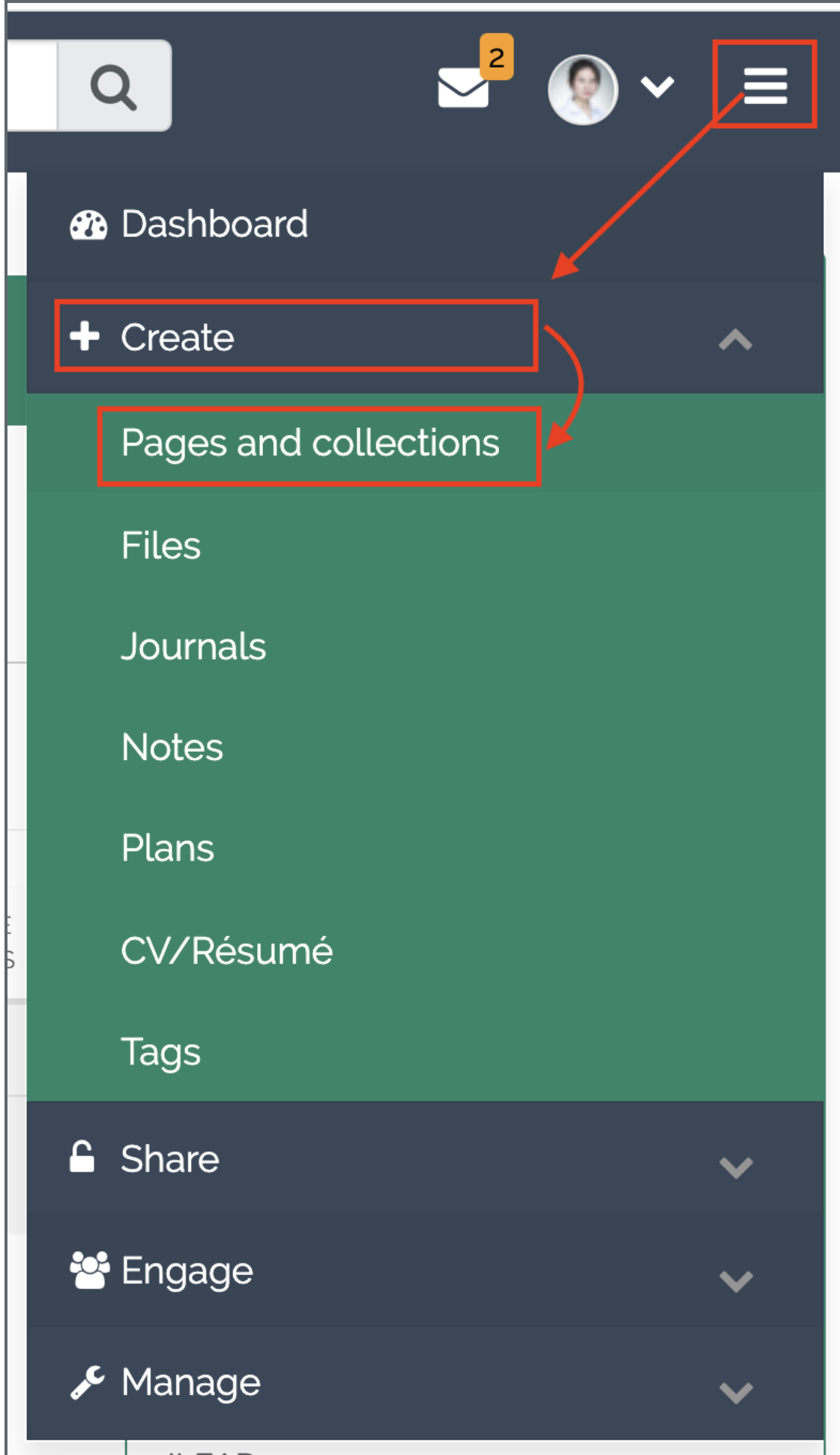

## Copy a page or collection

Here you can search through the pages that you are allowed to copy as a starting point for making a new page. You can see a preview of each page by clicking on its name. Once you have found the page you wish to copy, click the corresponding "Copy page" button to make a copy and begin customising it. You may also choose to copy the entire collection that the page belongs to by clicking the corresponding "Copy collection" button.
