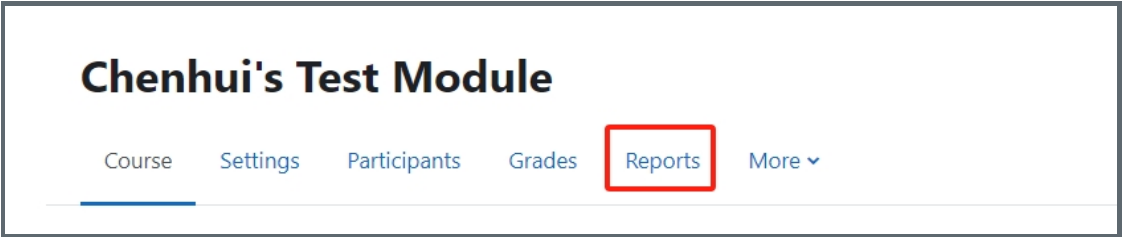
The Assignment report is on the module level page, but not inside each assignment activities.




