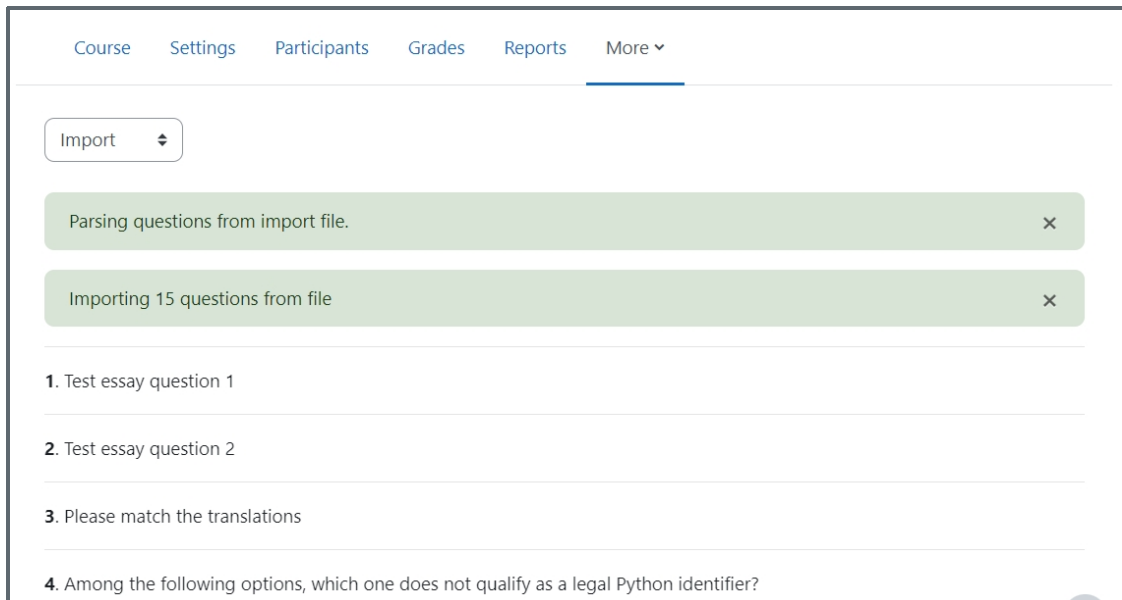


How to download and migrate the question bank from modules in AY22/23 to new module areas in AY23/24

Overview:

This guide will show you how to export questions from the AY22/23 Question bank to the AY23/24 modules for use on your new module page.

What to know:


It will walk you through the steps of exporting questions from your Question bank on your previous module so that you can get started recreating these activities on your new module in AY23/24.

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Step 1: AY22/23 module page

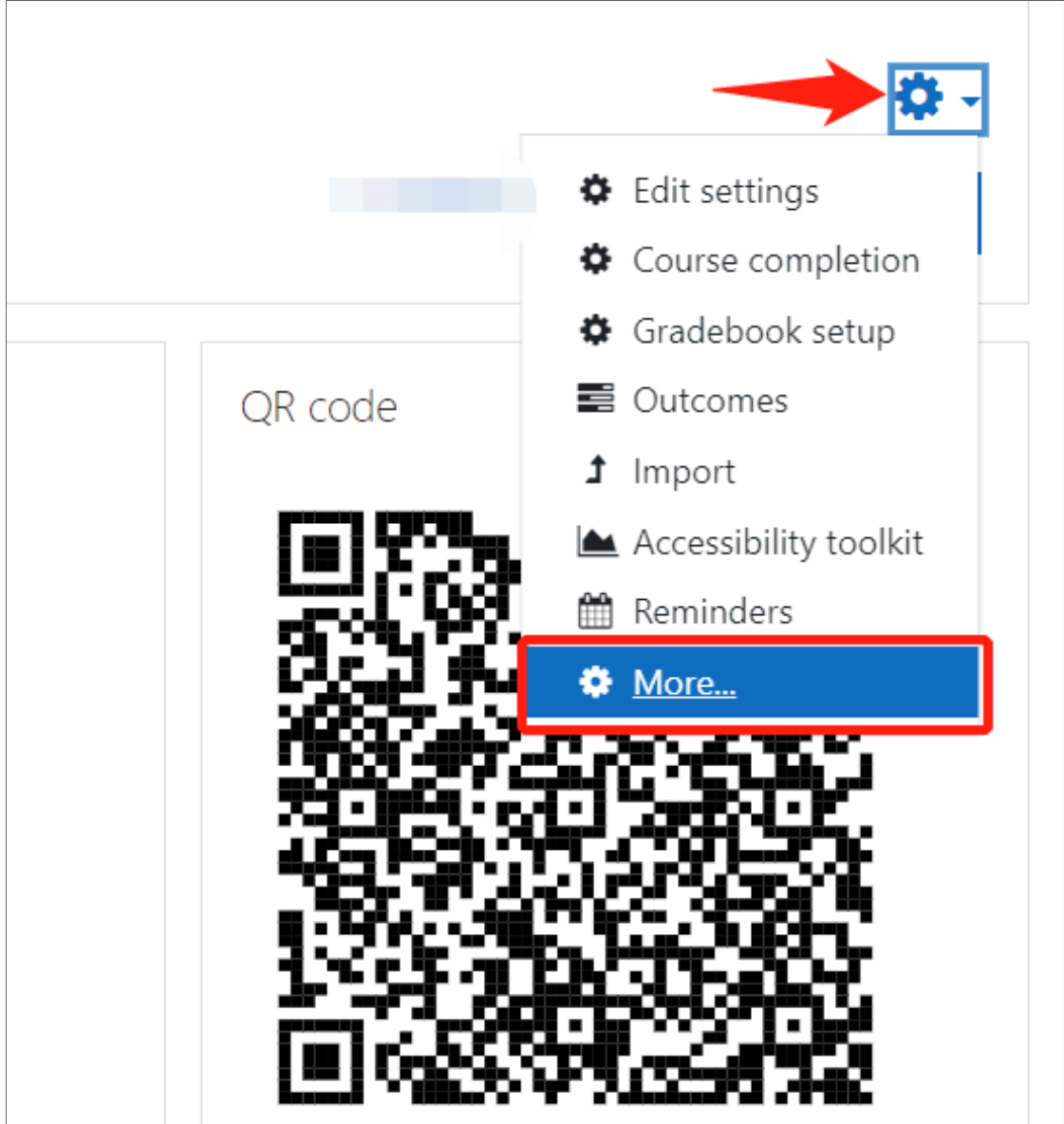
Go to your previous module page in AY22/23.

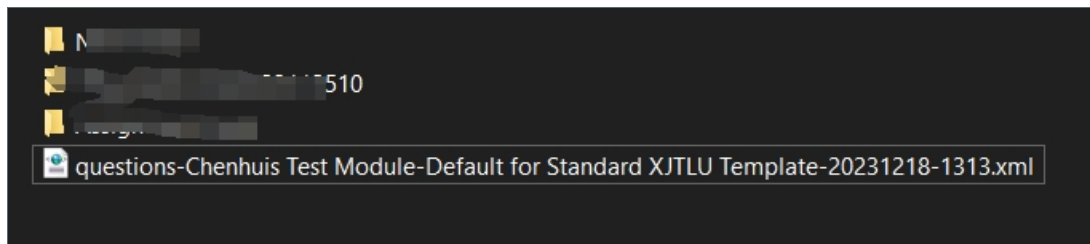

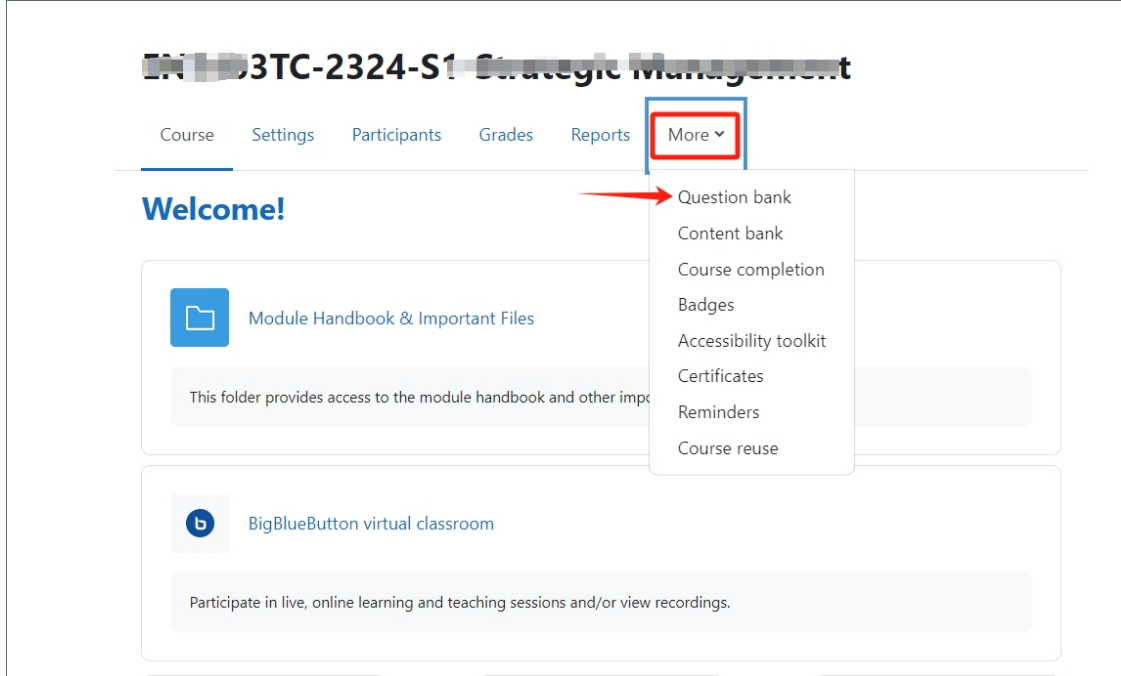
Step 6: Viewing your file on your computer

You'll now be able to see your file in the download folder.



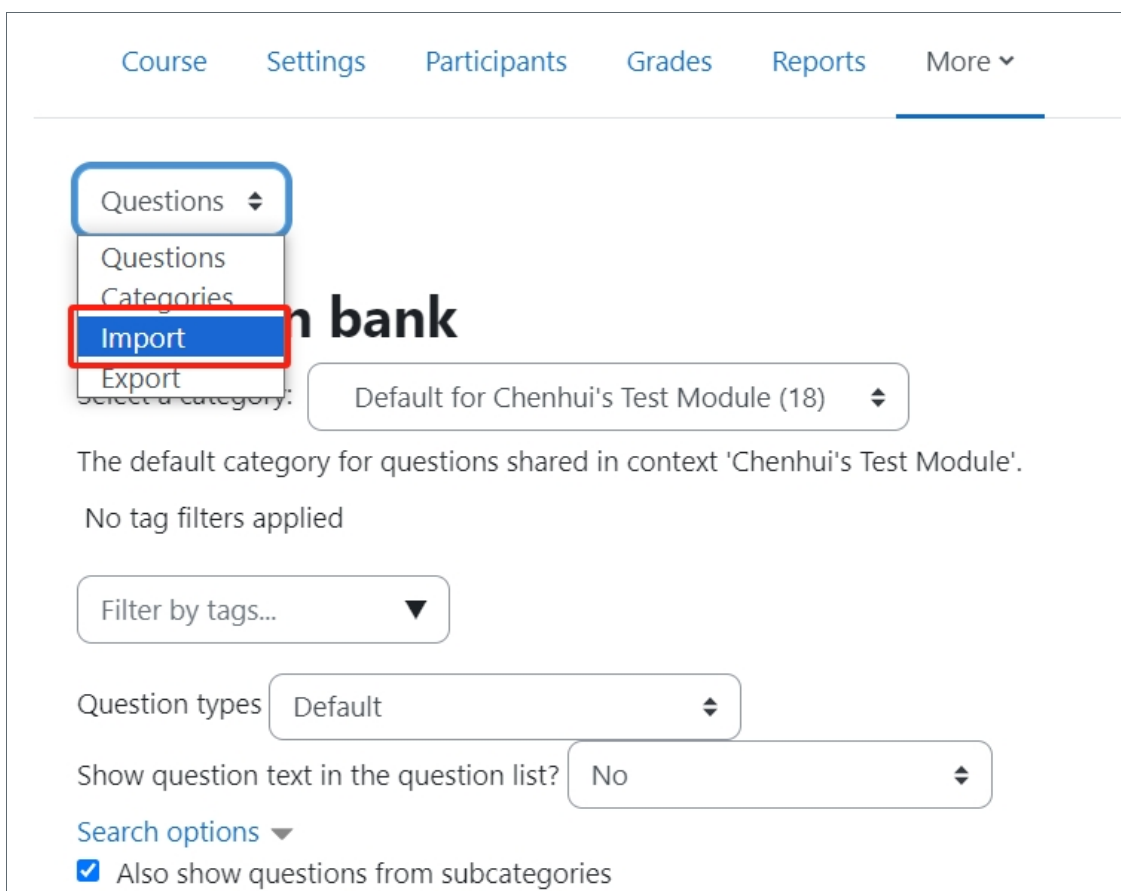
Step 7: AY23/24 Module page

Now on your new module page, click on the "more" button which is situated on the top right hand-corner of the course navigation bar. Then click 'Question Bank' in the drop down list.
