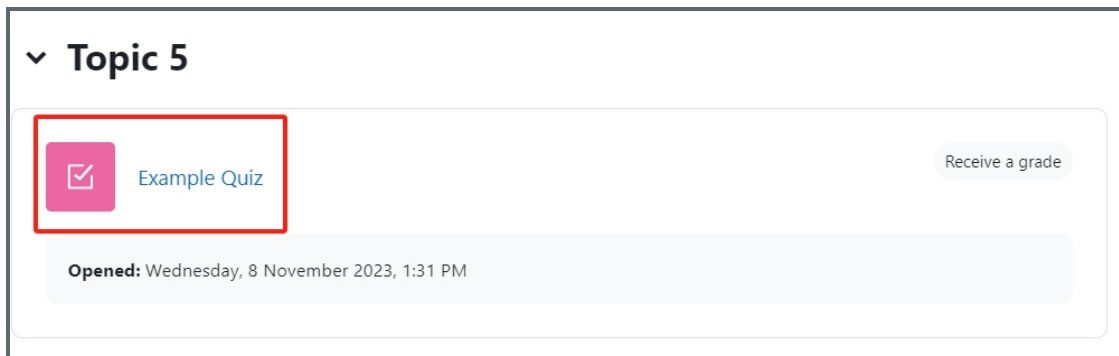

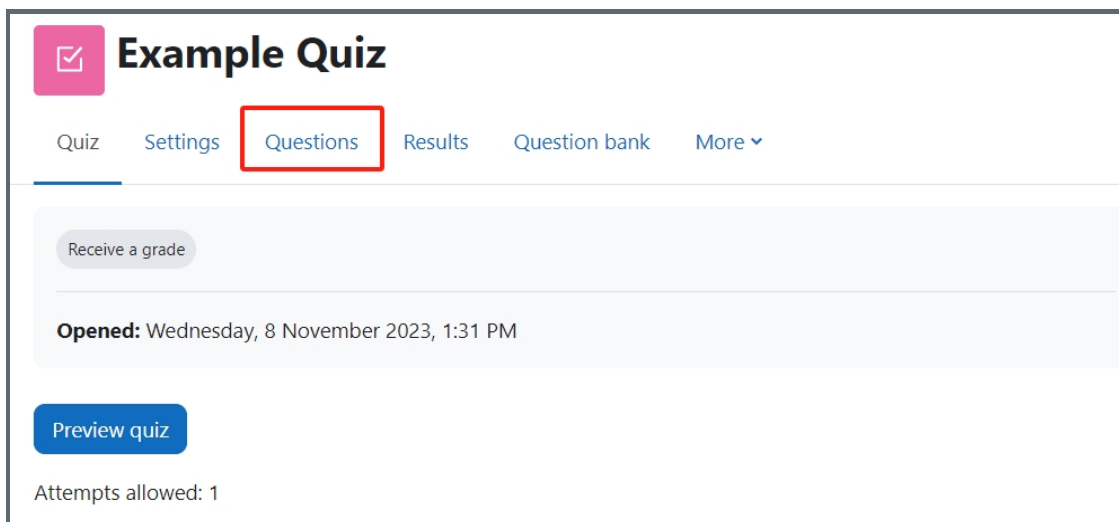
Step 1: Access the Quiz activity where you want to delete a question
