It will walk you through the steps of exporting questions from your Question bank on ICE so that you can get started recreating these activities on your new Learning Mall module .

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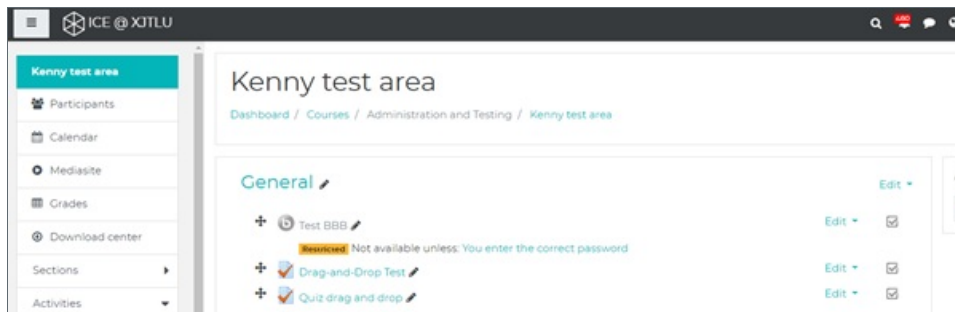
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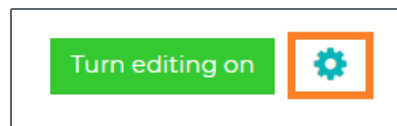
Step 1: ICE module page

Go to your ICE module page.

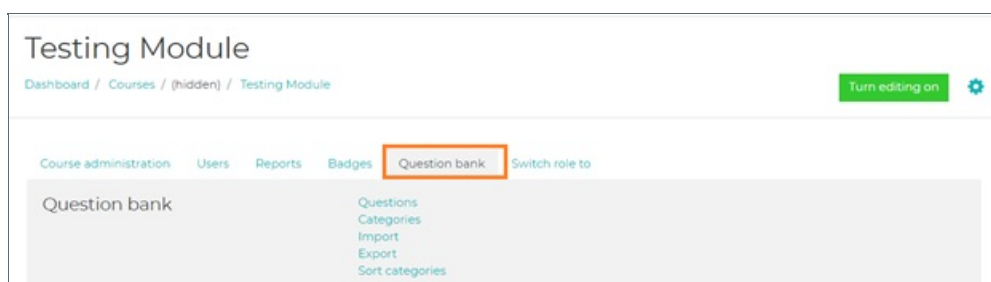


Step 2: Accessing your Question bank

You can access all of the quizzes on your module by clicking on the settings cog on the right -hand side of your screen on your module page,

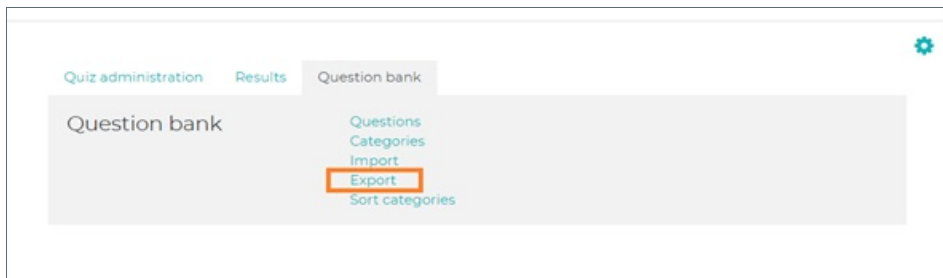


and then by clicking on the Question bank section from the subsequent drop-down menu



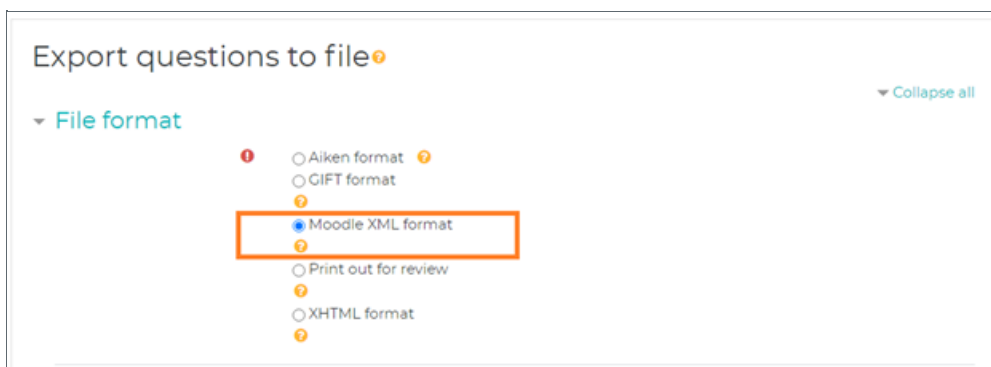
Step 3: Exporting your questions

Click on Export in the Question bank menu.



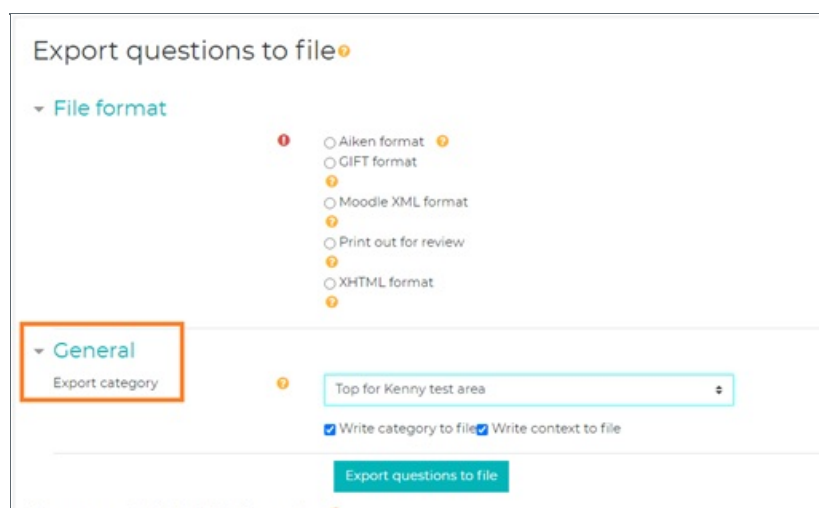
Step 4: Choosing a file format

Choose a file format in this case 'Moodle XML format'.



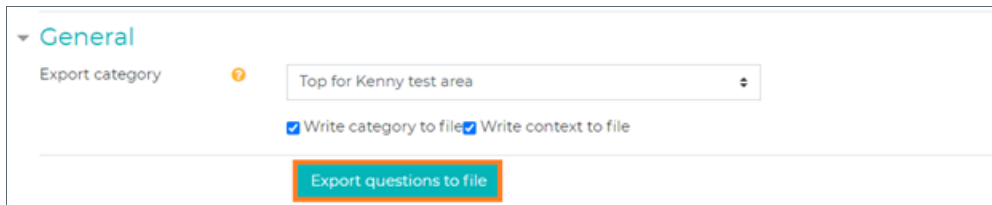
Step 5: Exporting

Then go down to the General section.



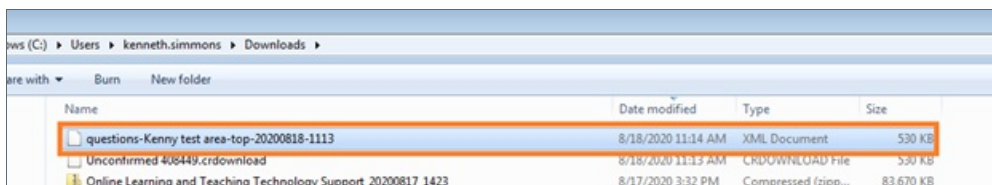
Step 6: Exporting your question to your computer

Now you can export your questions.



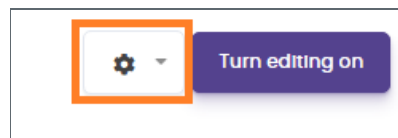
Step 7: Viewing your file on your computer

You'll now be able to see your file in the download folder.



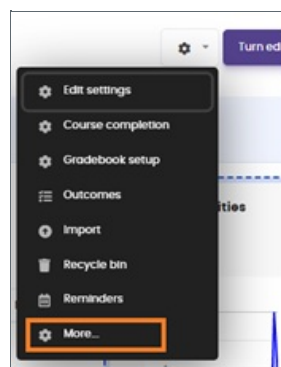
Step 8: The Learning Mall

Now on your new Learning Mall page go to the top right hand-corner of the screen and 'click' on the cog wheel which is situated close to the editing button.



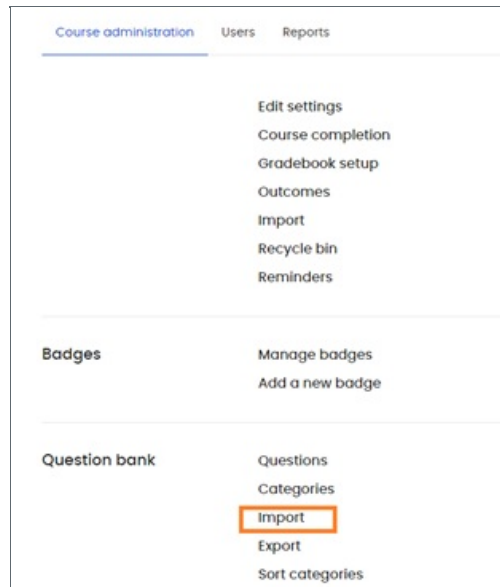
Step 9: The settings menu

Now from the setting drop-down menu 'click' more.



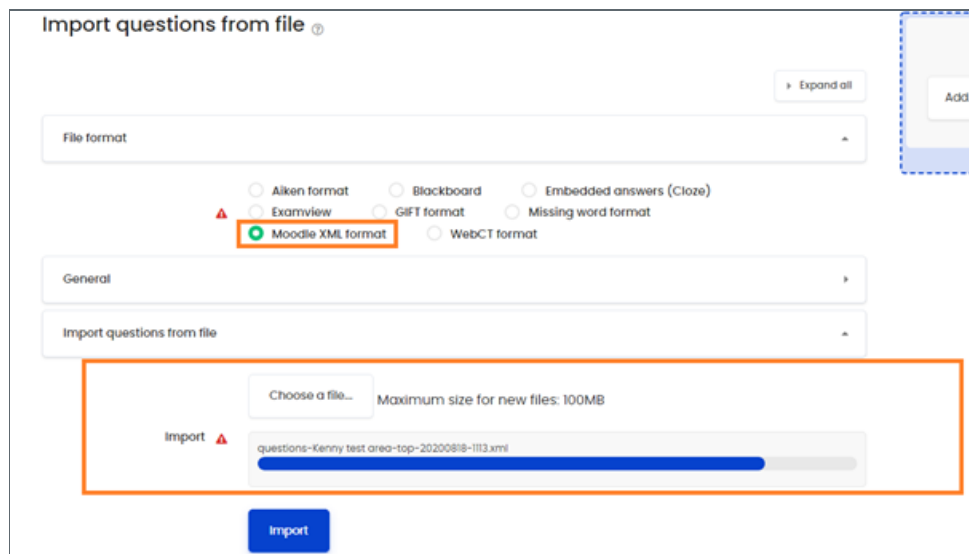
Step 10: Importing the questions

Go down to import under the Question Bank section.



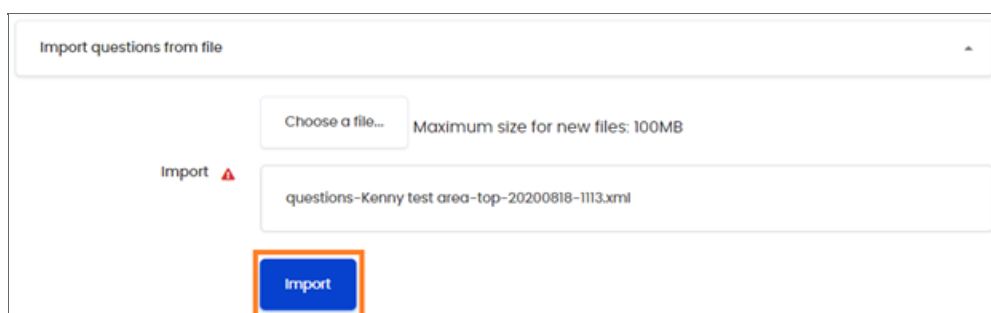
Step 11: Uploading to the Learning Mail

Choose the correct file format then drag and drop your file to upload it.




Step 12: Importing the questions

You'll see your imported questions listed.

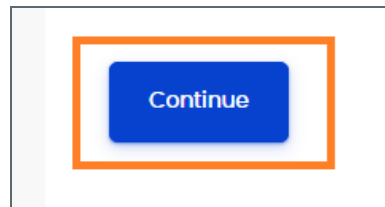
